A local law restricting Winter parking to facilitate highway maintenance

1. In order to protect the public safety and to facilitate winter maintenance and plowing of highways in the Town of Bellmont, no vehicles or trailers may be parked on any Town or County road or highway located in the Town of Bellmont from November 1, to April 1, such dates to be inclusive.
2. The Superintendent of Highways, or his agent, may order all offending vehicles or trailers to be towed.
3. The owner of any towed vehicle or trailer shall be fully responsible for the payment of all costs, including storage costs, incurred as a result of such towing.
4. The Town Superintendent of Highways, or his agent, is authorized but not required to have any such offending vehicle or trailer towed by Town equipment or stored on Town property. In that event Town towing charges shall be Forty Dollars (\$40.00) and storage charges shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per day, or any fraction thereof.
5. The owner of any vehicle or trailer parked in violation of this Local Law shall be guilty of an offense and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). Each day or portion thereof that a vehicle or trailer is parked in violation of this Local Law shall constitute a separate offense.
6. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
